Relation to curriculum	This course is an elective course which is presented in the second year/ fourth semester. This course supports students who want to concentrate on LBE Regional Planning, Mitigation and Tourism.
Type of teaching, contact hours	This course uses two learning methods: Project Based Learning, Cooperative (CoL) and Collaborative Learning (CbL). The first to the seventh week, learning is carried out using an interactive lecture method. The first until seven weeks will be discussed theories about Planning law. Furthermore, from the 9 th to the 15 th week, learning is carried out using the project-based learning method. Students are asked to identify issues and potential study locations/problem and develop targeted directions.
